### ARUM FIELDS CHENIN BLANC, DARLING CELLARS \* V/VE

125ml - £4.10, 175ml - £4.50, 250ml - £5.40, Bottle - £17  
Darling, Western Cape, South Africa Light and refreshing with subtle tropical fruit. Fresh, crisp and gently zingy. A tasty all round versatile white.

### ARTESA RIOJA BLANCO, BODEGAS ARTESA V/VE

125ml - £4.25, 175ml - £4.50, 250ml - £5.40, Bottle - £17  
Rioja, Spain 100% unoaked Viura. Fresh yet softly fruited with bright and breezy citrus fruit flavours. Refreshing, light textured and very clean tasting.

### BADAJO VERDEJO, BODEGA GOTICA

125ml - £4.25, 175ml - £4.50, 250ml - £5.40, Bottle - £17  
Rueda, Spain. This bodega, in Rueda itself, specialises in white wines with the emphasis on the native Verdejo variety and makes a very exciting range of wines showing different aspects of its fresh, citrusy, herbal quality.

### CAPARRONE PASSERINA, AZIENDA AGRICOLA CONTESA \* V/VE

125ml - £4.25, 175ml - £4.50, 250ml - £5.40, Bottle - £17  
Abruzzo, Italy. A delicate yet expressive rare Italian white grape variety with zingy lemon and grapefruit flavours. The Passerina grapes are sourced from vines grown on chalky clay soils at Silvi (on the Adriatic coast) and a little inland at Moscufo. The grapes are softly pressed and macerated on skins, at low temperature, for 8 hours. Fermentation is in stainless steel.

### BASCAND SAUVIGNON BLANC, BASCAND ESTATE

125ml - £4.25, 175ml - £4.50, 250ml - £5.40, Bottle - £17  
Marlborough, New Zealand. Excellent balance with freshness and subtle fruit in equal quantities. A good contrast to the more turbo charged examples from this region.

### VIDAL ESTATE HAWKES BAY CHARDONNAY, VIDAL V

125ml - £4.50, 175ml - £4.95, 250ml - £5.50, Bottle - £18  
Hawkes Bay, New Zealand. Great value - citrus, peach, oatmeal and hazelnut. Fresh texture and lovely purity. The delicate oak adds a delicious creamy sheen to the refreshing finish.

### SANVIGILIO PINOT GRIGIO, VIDAL V/VE

125ml - £4.25, 175ml - £4.50, 250ml - £5.40, Bottle - £17  
Lombardy, Italy. A Pinot Grigio with a little more character and style than you would perhaps expect. Very fresh with a so, fruity and fragrant style. Clean and tangy with a delicate yet tasty nish.

# REDS

## INDABA MOSAIC, INDABA WINES

125ml - £4.25, 175ml - £4.75, 250ml - £5.20, Bottle - £16

Western Cape, South Africa. A great value red brimming with rich and ripe textured blackcurrant, plum, spice and dark chocolate flavours. 78% Cabernet Sauvignon, 12% Merlot, 6% Cabernet Franc, 4% Petit Verdot.

## MONASTRELL ORGANIC, FAMILIA CASTAÑO \* V/VE

125ml - £4.25, 175ml - £4.75, 250ml - £5.20, Bottle - £16

Levante, Yecla, Spain. Bursting with cherries, plums, wild herbs and spice. Juicy, fresh, smooth and easy drinking.

## QUATRO VENTOS DOURO, ALIANCA VINHOS DE PORTUGAL V/VE

125ml - £4.25, 175ml - £4.80, 250ml - £5.40, Bottle - £17

A rich and warming amalgam of hedgerow berries, plum, liquorice and spice. Nothing hard edged. Ripe and easy drinking yet with real interest. One of Portugal's largest and most progressive producers with 600 hectares spread across estates in five regions from Douro in the north to Alentejo in the south.

## CONVIVIALE PRIMITIVO, IGT SALENTO, ADRIA VINI V/VE

125ml - £4.25, 175ml - £4.80, 250ml - 5.40, Bottle - £17

Italy - Puglia. A warm, richly flavoured red with aromas of blackberries, dried fruits, sweet spices, together with plum and black cherry fruit and hints of dried figs – with ripe tannins balanced by fresh acidity. Rich, characterful, southern red from the Manduria zone in the Salento region. This is the heartland of Primitivo – famed for generous, concentrated wines from old unirrigated bush vines.

## ARTESA RIOJA TEMPRANILLO, ARTESA

125ml - £4.25, 175ml - £4.75, 250ml - £5.20, Bottle - £16

Rioja, Spain. Excellent depth of flavour and that classic smooth and mellow Rioja charm, with juicy fruit and a hint of vanilla, oak and spice.

## AMAUTA ABSOLUTO MALBEC, EL PORVENIR DE CAFAYATE

125ml - £4.50, 175ml - £4.75, 250ml - £5.40, Bottle - £17

Cafayate, Salta, Argentina. A great bang for your buck Malbec! Produced in high (very!) altitude vineyards (Finca Río Seco vineyards located 1,700 mts above sea level) giving you a Malbec which, although full flavoured, is very well balanced, without being heavy or overblown.

## MONTEVISTA MERLOT V/VE

125ml - £4, 175ml - £4.75, 250ml - £5, Bottle - £15

Valle del Maule, Chile. A smooth, mellow and cossetting Merlot. Plenty of plum, cherry and bramble fruit with real drinkability. Slips down very easily!

# ROSÉ

## GRIS MARIN ROSÉ SABLE DE CAMARGUE 2018 V/VE

125ml - £4.50, 175ml - £4.75, 250ml - £5.40, Bottle - £17

Chateau L'Ermitage Southern France. Dry, delicate, elegant and fragrant. Hints of peach and redcurrant with a crystal clean and gently mineral and savoury overtone. A stylish and versatile rose. A lovely aperitif wine, or match with most non-spicy nibbles.
